He received no formal education but was taught at home by his father. During the 1840s, the young Spencer had begun to publish scientific and political articles in the *North British Review*. In 1854, he published his essay on the Art of Education, which was widely read and influential. The essay argued for a utilitarian and natural science education, emphasizing the family traditions of dissent and individualism.
